This summer, France hosts the Olympic and Paralympic Games

In Paris and its surrounding,

- Safety areas will be set close to competition venues.
- Therefore, you will need to prepare in advance for any journeys and activities taking place near those venues!



The rules regarding access around the sites where the sports events will take place vary,

You must **consult the interactive map** in order to know if you live or must travel to an area where traffic is limited





Blue area

No restriction. Motor vehicles must be driven by someone carrying a travel authorization.

Red area

<u>Close to competition venues.</u> Pedestrians allowed. Motor vehicles must be driven by someone carrying a 'Pass jeux'.

Grey area

<u>Competition venues.</u> Motor vehicles forbidden. Only pedestrians carrying a 'Pass jeux' are allowed.

92: Colombes, Nanterre

Your housing certificate (you can request it to the hotel

In case of medical appointment, make sure you carry a proof of this appointment
